## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT additional to the insolvent law of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Upon a discharge in insolvency being duly

- 2 granted, the debtor shall be forever thereafter dis-
- 3 charged and exempt from arrest or imprisonment
- 4 in any suit or upon any proceeding for or on ac-
- 5 count of any debt or demand which might have
- 6 been proved against his estate in insolvency by any
- 7 creditor wherever residing.
