AN ACT additional to the insolvent law of Maine.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Upon a discharge in insolvency being duly  
2 granted, the debtor shall be forever thereafter dis-  
3 charged and exempt from arrest or imprisonment  
4 in any suit or upon any proceeding for or on ac-  
5 count of any debt or demand which might have  
6 been proved against his estate in insolvency by any  
7 creditor wherever residing.
