STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the municipal officers of the
town of Weld to assess a tax upon school district
number five in said town.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The municipal officers of the town
2 of Weld are hereby authorized to assess upon the
3 polls and estates of the residents and owners in
4 school district number five in said town, and
5 collect, the sum of two hundred and seventy-seven
6 dollars and sixty-five cents, to reimburse said town
7 for money, being said sum paid out by said town
8 in making repairs upon the school-house in said
9 district, the assessment made for that purpose in
10 eighteen hundred and eighty-one being invalid.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
