STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to registers of probate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section twenty of chapter sixty-three of the 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by adding, 3 after the word "therefrom" in the seventh line, the 4 words "and any matter, petition, process or pro-5 ceeding drawn, commenced or conducted by the 6 register or his agent or clerk in the probate court 7 of which he is register, in violation of this act, 8 shall be void, and such register shall be liable in 9 damages to the party injured thereby." 1 s.
