STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the location of a town way into
tide waters at Hunnewell's point in Phipsburg.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The municipal officers of Phipsburg are hereby
2 authorized to locate a town way across the flats
3 between high and low water mark at Hunnewell's
4 point in said town to connect with a town way
5 located to high water mark in the same manner as
6 they are now authorized by law to locate town
7 ways not in tide waters; *provided*, they find that
8 such way will not obstruct navigation and that the
9 public convenience and necessity require it; and
10 damages therefor shall be assessed in the same
11 manner as now provided in case of lands taken for
12 town ways.
