## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize the construction of a bridge over tide waters between Orr's Island and Bailey's Island.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Authority is hereby given to lay out, con-
- 2 struct and maintain a bridge, with a draw suited to the
- 3 purposes of navigation, across and over the tide waters
- 4 separating Orr's Island from Bailey's Island, in the town
- 5 of Harpswell.
  - SECT. 2. The town of Harpswell shall have all the
- 2 powers relating to said bridge and its construction which
- 3 are provided by law in case of town ways.
  - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
