STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the jurisdictions of municipal
and police judges and trial justices in prosecutions
for Violation of the Fish and Game Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. In all prosecutions under chapter
2 thirty, Revised Statutes of the State of Maine, of
3 eighteen hundred and eighty-three, relating to
4 moose, deer, caribou and other wild game, and of
5 chapter forty, relating to fish and fisheries, and all
6 the acts amendatory of said chapters, municipal
7 and police judges and trial justices within their
8 counties have, by complaint, original and concur-

9 rent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial and
10 superior courts.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
