STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to the Clark & Chaplin Ice Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. With the consent of all the abutters
2 upon Long Creek in the town of Cape Elizabeth,
3 the Clark & Chaplin Ice Company may erect and
4 maintain a dam across the mouth of said creek,
5 and flow said creek and take and enjoy the exclu-
6 sive right of taking ice from said creek when
7 flowed, and may further acquire by purchase or
8 lease the flats and shores of said creek. Provided
9 the trustees of the reform school shall not consent
10 to anything herein contemplated, or dispose by

11 lease or sale of any interest in the flats or shores
12 of said Long Creek without the consent of the
13 city of Portland. And provided, further, this act
14 is subject to all the provisions of statutes already
15 in force or which may be hereafter passed relative
16 to Portland Harbor.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on approval.
