STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of Seal in the Saco Bay.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are prohibited from
2 killing, wounding or taking seal, and from firing
3 at, or otherwise molesting them, within one mlie
4 from the main land or any of the islands in Saco
5 Bay.

SECT. 2. Any persons violating the provisions of
2 this act shall forfeit ten dollars, and a further sum
3 of ten dollars for every seal by him killed, taken or
4 wounded in violation of this act, to be recovered
5 in an action of debt, one-half to the use of the

6 Fish and Game Protective Society of either York
7 or Cumberland counties, as the offense may be
8 committed within their respective limits, and the
9 other half to the prosecutors.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
