STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of Seal in the Saco Bay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All persons are prohibited from 2 killing, wounding or taking seal, and from firing 3 at, or otherwise molesting them, within one mlie 4 from the main land or any of the islands in Saco 5 Bay.

SECT. 2. Any persons violating the provisions of 2 this act shall forfeit ten dollars, and a further sum 3 of ten dollars for every seal by him killed, taken or 4 wounded in violation of this act, to be recovered 5 in an action of debt, one-half to the use of the

6 Fish and Game Protective Society of either York7 or Cumberland counties, as the offense may be8 committed within their respective limits, and the9 other half to the prosecutors.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
