## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the Compensation of County Commissioners for Piscataquis County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Each county commissioner for Pis-

- 2 cataquis county shall receive two dollars and fifty
- 3 cents per day while actually employed in the
- 4 service of the county, including the time spent in
- 5 traveling, for which he shall have ten cents a mile
- 6 for the distance actually traveled; but he shall not
- 7 have more than one travel in the same hearing or
- 8 session, nor for more than two adjournments of
- 9 any regular term, nor for service or travel on more
- 10 than one petition or case at the same time, nor

- 11 anything for travel or attendance at the legislature
- 12 connected with the annual county estimates, nor
- 13 for any additional trouble or expense of any kind.
