STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 17 of chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes, relating to Migratory Fish.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section seventeen of chapter forty of the Revised 2 Statutes is hereby amended as follows: After the 3 word "herring," in the first line of said section, insert 4 the word 'shad.' Strike out the word "two" in 5 the fourth line and in its place insert the word 6 'three.' Strike out the word "said" in the sixth 7 line and in its place insert the word 'any.' After 8 the words "or seines" in the sixth line, insert the 9 words 'employed in such unlawful fishing.' Strike 10 out the word "one" in the sixth line and in its

11 place insert 'three.' Strike out the word "three"
12 in the seventh line and in its place insert 'five.'
13 After the word "depth" in the fifteenth line, insert
14 the words 'and a net for meshing shad of not more
15 than seventy-five meshes in depth,' so that said
16 section as amended shall read as follows:

The taking of mackerel, herring, ^с Sect. 17. 18 shad, porgies, or menhaden, and the fishing there-19 for by the use of purse and drag seines is prohib-20 ited in all small bays, inlets, harbors or rivers, 21 where any entrance to the same, or any part there-22 of from land to land, is not more than three nauti-23 cal miles in width, under a penalty upon the master 24 or person in charge of such seines, or upon the 25 owners of any vessel or seines employed in such 26 unlawful fishing, of not less than three hundred, 27 nor more than five hundred, dollars, to be recovered 28 by indictment, or action of debt; one fourth of the 29 penalty to the complainant or prosecutor, and three 30 fourths to the county in which the proceedings are 31 commenced; and there shall be a lien upon the 32 vessels, steamers, boats and apparatus used in such 33 unlawful pursuit until said penalty, with costs of 34 prosecution, is paid; but a net for meshing mack-35 erel, or porgies, of not more than one hundred 36 meshes in depth, and a net for meshing herring, of 37 not more than one hundred and seventy meshes in38 depth, and a net for meshing shad, of not more39 than seventy-five meshes in depth, shall not be40 deemed a seine.
