STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the City of Saco and the
Trustees of Thornton Academy to contract for the
Tuition of Scholars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city of Saco and the Trustees
2 of Thornton Academy, a corporation existing
3 under a charter of this State, are hereby author-
4 ized to contract each with the other for the tuition
5 of scholars within said city for one or more years,
6 in the studies contemplated by the six preceding
7 sections, referred to in Revised Statutes, chapter
8 eleven, section thirty-four, and in such others as
9 may be agreed upon, under a standard of scholar-
10 ship to be mutually agreed upon and changeable

11 by agreement of the school committee or super-
12 visor of schools of said city and such trustees.

SECT. 2. The payment for such tuition by said
2 city may be in money or by lease to such trustees,
3 of buildings and grounds owned by said city, or
4 by both money and lease, and the expenditures of
5 said Saco under said contract, whether made from
6 year to year or wholly at the commencement of
7 the term of years, and whether in money or by
8 such lease, shall be subject to same conditions and
9 shall entitle said city to the same State aid as if it
10 had made such expenditures for a free high school.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
