## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred and thirty-two of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred

- 2 and thirty-two of the Revised Statutes is hereby
- 3 amended by inserting after the word "thereof"
- 4 in the fourth line the words 'and shall not be
- 5 diminished during their continuance in office,' so
- 6 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'SECT. 1. Judges of municipal and police courts

- 2 shall be appointed and shall hold their offices as
- 3 provided in the constitution. Their salaries, unless
- 4 established by law, shall be fixed by the municipal

5 officers of their towns, and paid quarterly from the 6 treasuries thereof, and shall not be diminished 7 during their continuance in office, and all fees 8 received by them shall be paid quarterly into said 9 treasuries, except when their compensation is fixed 10 by law, by the allowance to them in whole or in 11 part of the fees accruing in their courts. All fees 12 of such courts paid to the jailer, after commit-13 ment, shall be paid over by him, quarterly, into 14 said treasuries.'
