## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend Section thirteen of Chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirteen of chapter one hundred and six-

- 2 teen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended as
- 3 follows: By striking out the words "and in the
- 4 probate court" in the second line thereof, and in-
- 5 serting said words between the words "courts"
- 6 and "shall" in the first line thereof, so that said
- 7 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 13. Witnesses in the supreme judicial or

- 9 superior courts, and in the probate court, shall re-
- 10 ceive one dollar and fifty cents, or before the

11 county commissioners, one dollar for each day's 12 attendance and six cents for each mile's travel 13 going out and returning home; and before a justice 14 of the peace and of the quorum, a trial justice, a 15 judge of a municipal or police court, referees, 16 auditors or commissioners specially appointed to 17 take testimony, fifty cents a day for attendance 18 and for travel, the same as at the courts aforesaid.'
