AMENDMENT "A."

Amend House Document Number 51, page
2 two, line sixteen, by inserting after the word "di-
3 rect" the words 'and *provided*, also, that said
4 bridges shall not be built until there be constructed
5 and completed a railroad from some point on the
6 main line of the International Railway to Green-
7 ville, and at said Greenville a connection of the
8 same guage be made with the Bangor & Piscata-
9 quis Railroad at its northern terminus in said
10 Greenville, such branch line to be constructed in a
11 manner equal to that of the main line of said Inter-

12 national Railway.' Also, by inserting the same
13 words after the word "direct" on page three, line
14 fifty-five.
