## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT in relation to Mt. Clark and Chaplin Ice  
Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. With the consent of all the abutters  
2 upon Long Creek in the town of Cape Elizabeth,  
3 Mt. Clark and Chaplin Ice Company may erect and  
4 maintain a dam across the mouth of said creek, and  
5 flow said creek, except such parts thereof as may  
6 now be used for purposes of cutting ice, and take  
7 and enjoy the exclusive right of taking ice from  
8 said creek, excepting said parts thereof, when  
9 flowed, and may further acquire by purchase or  
10 lease the flats and shores of said creek. *Provided,*

11 the trustees of the reform school shall not consent  
12 to anything herein contemplated, or dispose by lease  
13 or sale of any interest in the flats or shores of said  
14 Long Creek without the consent of the city of  
15 Portland. And *provided, further*, this act is sub-  
16 ject to all the provisions of statutes already in force  
17 or which may be hereafter passed relative to Port-  
18 land harbor. And *provided, further*, that nothing  
19 in this act shall be so construed as to prevent the  
20 laying out of a public road across said creek or  
21 dam. And such road when so laid out shall be  
22 under the exclusive control of the county commis-  
23 sioners of the county of Cumberland. And all  
24 cost attending said road shall be assessed upon the  
25 town of Cape Elizabeth and Mt. Clark and Chap-  
26 lin Ice Company, their successors and assigns, in  
27 such parts and at such times as said county com-  
28 missioners may determine. And said assessments  
29 may be collected by said commissioners by an  
30 action for debt.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
