STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Alvra H. Libbey of Lewiston.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the treasury 2 of the State to Alvra H. Libbey of Lewiston, the 3 sum of eight dollars per month as a military pen-4 sion, during the pleasure of the Legislature, com-5 mencing January first, eighteen hundred and 6 eighty-five.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Alvra H. Libbey of Lewiston, a private in the First Battery of Light Artillery, Maine Volunteer Militia, while on duty as a member of said Battery, at the encampment of the militia at Augusta, on the 23d day of September, 1883, was injured by the premature discharge of a cannon, said injury necessitating the amputation of three fingers of his right hand.
