S. 16—House Amendment.

STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to Incorporate the Plantation of Allegash, in the County of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The townships in Aroostook county 2 numbered sixteen and seventeen in the tenth range, 3 sixteen and seventeen in the eleventh range, be and 4 are hereby incorporated into a plantation, by the 5 name of Allegash, having all the powers of towns 6 in relation to laying out, building and repairing of 7 roads and bridges; raising and collecting of money 8 by taxation for the following purposes, to wit: the 9 making and repairing roads and bridges, building

10 and repairing school houses, and the support of 11 schools and plantation purposes.

SECT. 2. The plantation is hereby exempt from 2 state and county tax as a plantation until eighteen 3 hundred ninety-one. William Dickey or A. G. 4 Fenlason, or either of them, are authorized to call the 5 first meeting for the organization of said plantation 6 by posting up two warrants in said plantation seven 7 days prior to the meeting in the month of March 8 or April following the approval of this act and 9 make return of the organization of said plantation 10 to the secretary of state.
