STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of Revised Statutes, relating to the sale of Unwholesome Food, &c.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter one hundred
2 and twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "agent" in
4 the first line thereof the word 'manufactures,' and
5 by striking out all after the word "cream" in the fifth
6 line thereof and substituting therefor the follow-
7 ing, viz: 'Whether said article, substance or com-
8 pound be named oleomargarine, butterine, or oth-
9 wise named, forfeits for the first offence one hun-
10 dred dollars, and for the second and each subse-

11 quent offence two hundred dollars, to be recovered
12 by indictment with costs. And it shall be the duty
13 of every inspector of milk, sheriff, deputy sheriff,
14 and constable as named in section five (5) of this
15 chapter, to institute complaint against any person
16 or persons violating the above named provisions of
17 said third section.' So that said section as amend-
18 ed shall read as follows:

19 'SECT. 3. Whoever by himself or his agent,
20 manufactures, sells, exposes for sale, or has in his
21 possession with intent to sell any article, substance
22 or compound made in imitation of butter or cheese,
23 or as a substitute for butter or cheese, and not
24 made exclusively and wholly of cream or milk, or
25 containing any fats, oils, or grease not produced
26 from milk or cream, whether said article, substance
27 or compound be named oleomargarine, butterine, or
28 otherwise named, forfeits for the first offence one
29 hundred dollars, and for the second and each sub-
30 sequent offence two hundred dollars, to be re-
31 covered by indictment with costs. And it shall be
32 the duty of every inspector of milk, sheriff, deputy
33 sheriff, and constable as named in section five of
34 this chapter to institute complaint against any per-
35 son or persons violating the above named pro-
36 visions of said third section.'

SECT. 2. Section four of chapter one hundred
2 and twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes is hereby
3 repealed.
