IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

#### Amendment "A" to House Document No. 25.

Strike out all of section two after the word 2 "branch," in line sixty-seven on page five, and 3 insert the following words: 'Or by reason of the 4 use or the detention of the water, in any manner 5 not authorized by said act and the common law, 6 may be determined by the courts in appropriate 7 proceedings at law or in equity, in accordance with 8 law; and in an action for said damages, the quesgoin of the practical sufficiency and necessity of 10 said water, in its natural condition, to float logs, 11 rafts and lumber over said falls, or through said

- 12 sluices and below the same, shall be left to the jury
- 13 to determine under appropriate instructions by the
- 14 presiding judge.'
