IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section four of chapter one hundred forty of Revised Statutes, relating to the State Prison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter one hun-2 dred and forty is hereby amended so as to read as 3 follows:—

'SECT. 4. The supervision of the State Prison 5 is vested in the Governor and Council, but its 6 government and direction are in a board of three 7 prison and jail inspectors, one warden, one deputy 8 warden, one clerk, one commissary, ten guards,
