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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section four of chapter one hundred forty of Revised Statutes, relating to the State Prison.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter one hundred and forty is hereby amended so as to read as follows:—

‘SECT. 4. The supervision of the State Prison is vested in the Governor and Council, but its government and direction are in a board of three prison and jail inspectors, one warden, one deputy warden, one clerk, one commissary, ten guards,

9 and such number of overseers and aids as the in-  
10 spectors determine to be necessary.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
