STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to provide for the proper expenditure of School Funds in Plantations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All moneys due plantations from the

- 2 State treasury for school purposes, shall be paid to
- 3 the treasurers of such plantations, under the same
- 4 conditions as in case of towns, and the same shall
- 5 be expended by such plantations under the same
- 6 restrictions and limitations as are required of towns.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent

2 with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
