### STATE OF MAINE.

#### RESOLVE in favor of Eugine Michaud.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the State

- 2 treasury to Eugine Michaud the sum of sixty-seven
- 3 and twelve one-hundredths dollars for money paid
- 4 by said Michaud for lots numbered forty-four in
- 5 Wallagrass Plantation, July eleventh, eighteen
- 6 hundred forty-nine.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

In the year 1849, Zebulon, called Eugine, Michaud paid the State for lot 44 in cash, and the same lot was awarded to the said Michaud under the treaty of Washington, and the State received from the United States the cash for the same lot, at the rate of \$1.25 per acre. The cash was paid to the State July 11th, 1849, at fifty cents per acre.
