AN ACT to amend chapter eight of the Revised  
Statutes, relating to Making and Printing Reports  
of County Treasurers.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section ten of chapter eight of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking  
3 out in the first line the words, "the treasurer of  
4 the county of Cumberland," and inserting the  
5 words 'Each treasurer.' Said section is further  
6 amended by inserting after the word "finances,"  
7 the words, 'including the number of weeks' board  
8 and expense of clothing furnished prisoners,' so  
9 that said section shall read as follows:

'SECT. 10. Each treasurer shall at the end of  
11 each year, in connection with the commissioners,  
12 make a statement of its financial condition, show-  
13 ing in detail all moneys received into and paid out  
14 of its treasury, and other facts and statistics ne-  
15 cessary to exhibit the true state of its finances, in-  
16 cluding the number of weeks' board and expense  
17 of clothing furnished prisoners, and shall publish  
18 in pamphlet form a reasonable number of copies  
19 for distribution among its citizens.'

SECT. 2. Section nine of chapter eight of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
