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STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section twenty-one of chapter  
seventy of the Revised Statutes relating to sales of  
property under proceedings in insolvency.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

That section twenty-one of chapter seventy of  
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by strik-  
3 ing out in the second line of said section the words  
4 "after due public notice and," so that as amended  
5 said section shall read as follows:

'SECT. 21. Upon application, in writing, of any  
7 party interested, and notice to the debtor, the  
8 judge may order the messenger to sell, for cash,  
9 in such manner as he directs, any part of the  
10 debtor's estate; and in his own name, as messenger,

11 to collect and receive debts due such insolvent,  
12 and such messenger shall keep a correct account  
13 of the names of the purchasers, the articles sold  
14 and the prices received therefor, and of all debts  
15 collected by him.
