AN ACT to amend section eighty-eight of chapter forty-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to Insurance Companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

In Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eighty-eight of chapter forty-nine of the

- 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking
- 3 out the word "takes," in the fourth line, and in-
- 4 serting in place thereof the word 'issues,' so that
- 5 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 88. Every foreign insurance company

- 7 doing business in this State, shall annually pub-
- 8 lish, three weeks successively, in some daily or
- 9 weekly paper printed in every county where it has
- 10 a duly authorized agent, or issues policies, a con-

- 11 densed statement of its condition conformable to
- 12 its last annual report to the Commissioner; and
- 13 any such insurance company which neglects or
- 14 refuses to publish such statement, forfeits not less
- 15 than fifty dollars.'
