STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section forty-five, chapter two hundred and twenty-five, Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter two hundred and

- 2 twenty-five, Public Laws of eighteen hundred
- 3 and eighty, is hereby amended by adding the fol-
- 4 lowing words after "brigadier general," in the
- 5 second line, one medical director with the rank
- 6 of major,' and by striking out the word "and," in
- 7 the last line of said section, and adding the fol-
- 8 lowing words to the end thereof, 'and one hospital
- 9 steward,' so that said section, when amended, shall
- 10 read as follows:

'Sect. 45. To each brigade there shall be one brigadier general, one medical director with the rank of major, one assistant adjutant general, one brigade inspector, each with the rank of major, one quartermaster, one commissary and one aid-de-camp, each with the rank of captain, one aid-de-camp with the rank of first lieutenant, and one hospital steward.'
