RESOLVE in favor of Cyrenus B. Downs of Winterport.

Resolved, That there be paid Cyrenus B. Downs

- 2 of Winterport, the sum of three hundred dollars
- 3 out of the State treasury for commutation money
- 4 paid by him in August, eighteen hundred and sixty-
- 5 three.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

I was drafted in August, 1863, but in consequence of sickness in my family, could not go and had to pay the commutation money of \$300. In March, 1864, I enlisted in the 14th M. V. M., for which I received a State bounty of \$300, and afterwards from the United States \$150, and in consequence leaving me the latter bounty in all; whereas, I think in justice the State ought to return me the commutation money paid by me under the circumstances. At that time, under that call, the town of Winterport paid no bounty.
