IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

House Amendment "A" to Senate Document No. 124.

Amend line thirteen, section twenty-one, by strik-2 ing out the word "eight" before the word "cents"
3 and inserting instead thereof the word 'ten,' so
4 that said section as amended shall read as follows:
SECT. 21. Each commissioner shall receive two
6 dollars and fifty cents a day while actually em-7 ployed in the service of the county, including the
8 time spentin travelling, for which every commissioner
9 shall have ten cents a mile for the distance actually
10 travelled, but no commissioner shall have more
11 than one travel during the same hearing or ses-

12 sion, nor for more than two adjournments of any 13 regular term; nor for service or travel on more 14 than one petition or case at the same time; nor15 anything for travel or attendance at the Legisla-16 ture connected with the annual county estimates;17 nor for any additional trouble or expense.
