House Amendment "A" to Senate Document No. 124.

Amend line thirteen, section twenty-one, by striking out the word "eight" before the word "cents" and inserting instead thereof the word 'ten,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

SECT. 21. Each commissioner shall receive two dollars and fifty cents a day while actually employed in the service of the county, including the time spent in travelling, for which every commissioner shall have ten cents a mile for the distance actually travelled, but no commissioner shall have more than one travel during the same hearing or session, nor for more than two adjournments of any regular term; nor for service or travel on more

14 than one petition or case at the same time; nor
15 anything for travel or attendance at the Legisla-
16 ture connected with the annual county estimates;
17 nor for any additional trouble or expense.
