RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Frankfort.

Resolved, That there be paid by the Treasurer of
2 the State, out of the school funds of the current
3 year, to the town of Frankfort, the sum of sixty-
4 eight dollars and sixty-four cents, it being a balance
5 equitably due said town as its proportion of the
6 school funds for the year eighteen hundred eighty-
7 four.
