STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT additional to chapter eighteen of the
Revised Statutes, relating to Injuries on Highways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Any suit hereafter brought under
2 section eighty of said chapter shall not be defeated
3 on account of the form of the notice as to an
4 alleged injury; *provided* it shall appear upon the
5 trial that any municipal officer, road commis-
6 sioner or highway surveyor of the town in which
7 the alleged injury was sustained had actual notice,
8 within fourteen days thereafter, of the time, place
9 and nature of the injury, and that a claim for
10 damages would be made.

SECT. 2. This act shall not apply to or affect
2 pending actions.
