# STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend an act to Incorporate the Van Buren Lumbering and Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 2, chapter 34 of the special and private 2 laws of 1881, is hereby amended by striking out 3 the words "connected therewith," in the eleventh 4 line, and inserting after the word "booms," in the 5 tenth line, 'with suitable piers there and elsewhere,' 6 so that the section as amended shall read as follows: 7 Said corporation is authorized to manufacture lum-8 ber and such other articles as may be conveniently 9 connected therewith, with power to purchase, hold 10 and sell such articles, and with power to lease,

11 purchase and hold such real and personal estate as 12 may be deemed expedient; also to make such by-13 laws and regulations for the management and gov-14 ernment of said corporation as may be deemed 15 necessary and proper. The said corporation is 16 authorized to erect mills on land which it may ac-17 quire by purchase at Van Buren, in the county of 18 Aroostook, and to maintain a boom or booms with 19 suitable piers there and elsewhere on the St. John 20 river, for the purpose of holding logs for said 21 mills. Not, however, in any manner to interfere 22 with the free navigation of said river.
