STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to Scientific Temperance Instruc-
tion in Public Schools.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Provision shall be made by the pro-
2 per local school authorities for instructing all pupils
3 in all schools supported by public money or under
4 State control in physiology and hygiene with
5 special reference to the effects of alcoholic drinks,
6 stimulants and narcotics upon the human system.

SECT. 2. No certificate shall be granted any
2 person to teach in the public schools of their State
3 after the fourth day of July, eighteen hundred and
4 eighty-five, who has not passed a satisfactory ex-

5 amination in physiology and hygiene with special
6 reference to the effects of alcoholic drinks, stimu-
7 lants and narcotics upon the human system.
