STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize Thomas Spear and others to
Build a Dam across Muddy River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Thomas Spear, Henry Carey, Albert M. Spear
2 and George O. Spear, their heirs and assigns, are
3 hereby authorized to construct and support a dyke
4 or dam across Muddy River, so called, in the town
5 of Topsham in the county of Sagadahoc, near the
6 bridge across said river, upon the road leading
7 from Bowdoinham, in said county, to Bath, with
8 suitable gates to regulate the flow of the tide, for
9 the purpose of draining, irrigating, and improving
10 the meadow lands lying upon said river, subject to

11 the laws of the State in relation to flowage; and
12 said dam shall not be erected without the written
13 consent of all the abutters upon said river, above
14 said dam, whose land may be affected thereby.
