IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to Prevent the Taking of Fish from the  
Tributaries of Wilson Pond in the City of Auburn,  
for the term of six years.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No fish of any kind shall be taken  
2 from the tributaries of Wilson Pond in the city of  
3 Auburn, county of Androscoggin, with hook and  
4 line, or in any other way, for the period of six years.

SECT. 2. The penalty for the violation of this  
2 act shall be a fine of not more than fifteen dollars,  
3 for each fish so taken, to be recovered on com-  
4 plaint before the municipal court for the city of

5 Auburn, one-half to the complainant and one-half  
6 to the city of Auburn.

SECT. 3. To take effect when approved.
