## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to Prevent the Taking of Fish from the Tributaries of Wilson Pond in the City of Auburn, for the term of six years.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No fish of any kind shall be taken

- 2 from the tributaries of Wilson Pond in the city of
- 3 Auburn, county of Androscoggin, with hook and
- 4 line, or in any other way, for the period of six years.

SECT. 2. The penalty for the violation of this

- 2 act shall be a fine of not more than fifteen dollars,
- 3 for each fish so taken, to be recovered on com-
- 4 plaint before the municipal court for the city of

- 5 Auburn, one-half to the complainant and one-half
- 6 to the city of Auburn.

Sect. 3. To take effect when approved.
