STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of fish in Allen Pond in the town of Greene, county of Androscoggin.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No fish of any kind shall be taken

- 2 from Allen Pond, in the town of Greene and
- 3 county of Androscoggin, with hook and line,
- 4 through the ice, or in any other way, between the
- 5 first day of November and the first day of May of
- 6 each year. The penalty for the violation of this
- 7 act shall be a fine of not more than ten dollars for
- 8 each fish so taken, to be recovered on complaint
- 9 before any trial justice, police or municipal court
- 10 in said county of Androscoggin, one-half to go
- 11 to the complainant.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
