## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the Taking of Fish from Taylor Pond and its outlet, in the City of Auburn.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are forbidden and pro-

- 2 hibited hereby to take fish of any kind from
- 3 Taylor Pond and its outlet, as far down stream as
- 4 the lower mill dam of H. and M. Willis, in the
- 5 city of Auburn, County of Androscoggin, for the
- 6 term of five years.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of

- 2 this act shall be liable to a fine of five dollars for
- 3 each fish so taken, to be recovered on complaint

- 4 before the municipal court for the city of Auburn,
- $\boldsymbol{5}$  one-half to the complainant and one-half to the
- 6 city of Auburn.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
