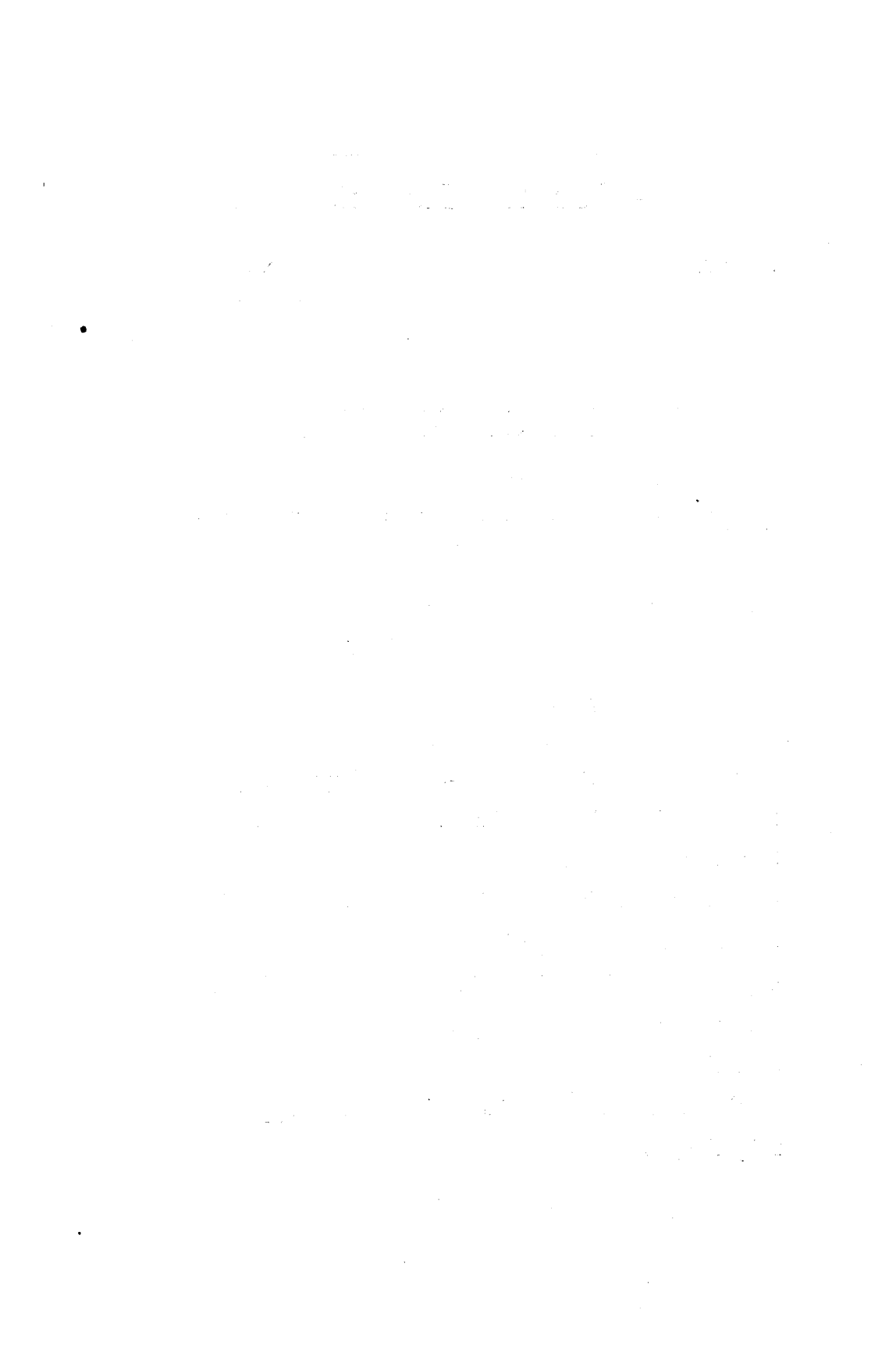
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to taking of Alewives by town
of Warren, in Georges River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section forty-one of chapter forty of
2 the Revised Statutes shall not apply to the taking
3 of alewives by the town of Warren, in the Georges
4 River, under the authority granted said town by
5 the Private and Special Laws of Massachusetts,
6 passed March sixth, eighteen hundred and two,
7 and amendments thereto passed by the Legislature
8 of this State.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on approval
2 by the governor.
