IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the Governor, with the advice
and consent of Council, to appoint some person to
be Register of Deeds for Franklin County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The Governor, with the advice and consent of
2 Council, is hereby authorized to appoint some
3 person, without regard to sex, to fill the present
4 vacancy in the office of registry of deeds for the
5 county of Franklin.
