STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prevent the throwing of Slabs and other
refuse into the Meduxnekeag Stream.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall throw or
2 put into that part of the Meduxnekeag stream
3 running through and above Houlton, or its tribu-
4 taries, any waste material coming from the manu-
5 facture of shingles, or any slabs or edgings from
6 the manufacture of laths, or lumber of any kind.

SECT. 2. Any person who violates the provisions
2 of section one shall be subject to a penalty of not
3 less than five dollars and not more than twenty
4 dollars, to be recovered in an action of debt by any
5 party injured, or by indictment.
