STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT providing for the choice of Park Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Towns and cities may choose by ballot 2 park commissioners to hold office one, two 3 and three years respectively, and after the first 4 year choose annually a commissioner for three 5 years in place of one whose term expires; they 6 shall have the care and superintendence of the 7 public parks and direct the expenditures of all 8 moneys appropriated for the improvement of the 9 same.
