STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of State Normal Schools.

Resolved, That for repairs and improvements of
2 the buildings and grounds of the three normal
3 schools established and maintained by the State,
4 there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of
5 fifteen hundred dollars for the year eighteen hun-
6 dred and eighty-five, and the like sum of fifteen
7 hundred dollars for the year eighteen hundred and
8 eighty-six, the same to be expended under the
9 direction of the trustees of normal schools.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The repairs and improvements for which this resolve provides are as follows:—

For new piping, radiators, &c., and repairs on heating apparatus,	\$ 725 00
For covering steam pipes to prevent waste of heat,	100 00
For sewerage and water supply,	350 00
For new floors,	150 00
For improving ventilation of school rooms and water closets,	50 00
For plastering, painting, varnishing, &c.,	275 00
For new furniture for school and recitation rooms,	200 00
For repairs on roofs,	75 00
For grading and improving grounds,	900 00
For new apparatus,	175 00

These estimates have been carefully made by the local Trustees, and the repairs and improvements indicated are considered by the full Board of Trustees to be absolutely necessary.
