STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section five of chapter two hundred and eighty-one, special laws of 1883, entitled an act to incorporate the City of Waterville.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

To amend section five of chapter two hundred 2 and eighty-one, special laws of 1883, by striking 3 out in line eight, the words "a majority" and sub-4 stituting the words 'two-thirds,' so that said section 5 shall read as follows:

6 'Every law, act, ordinance or bill appropriating
7 money, having passed the board of aldermen, shall
8 be presented to the mayor, and if he approve the
9 same, he shall sign it, if not, he shall return it

10 within seven days, with his objections, to the board 11 of aldermen, which shall enter the objections at 12 large on its journals, and proceed to reconsider 13 said act, ordinance or bill. If upon such re-con-14 sideration, two-thirds of the whole number of the 15 board of aldermen shall agree to pass it, it shall 16 have the same effect as if signed by the mayor.
