STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to change the name of the Cumberland
Farmers' Club, and to give it additional powers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The name of the Cumberland
2 Farmers' Club is hereby changed to the Cumber-
3 land County Central Agricultural Society.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is invested with all
2 the powers and privileges of an agricultural
3 society, as provided in chapter fifty-eight of the
4 Revised Statutes, for the towns of Cumberland,
5 Windham, Gray, New Gloucester, Pownal, Free-
6 port, Yarmouth and North Yarmouth, in the
7 county of Cumberland, and is made subject to the
8 duties and liabilities of similar corporations.

SECT. 3. It may acquire and hold, for the purposes for which it is organized, property, real and personal, to an amount not exceeding twenty thousand dollars.

SECT. 4. This act takes effect when approved.
