STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT to set off a portion of the town of Weston
in the County of Aroostook, and annex the same to
the town of Danforth in the County of Washington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All that portion of the town of Wes-
2 ton in the county of Aroostook, lying west or south-
3 west of Baskehegan Stream, so called, is hereby
4 set off, and the same is annexed to the town of
5 Danforth in the county of Washington.

SECT. 2. The county line between the said coun-
2 ties of Aroostook and Washington is hereby
3 changed in accordance with the provisions of sec-
4 tion one.
