STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-FIVE.

AN ACT relative to the Election of Assessors and
Overseers of the Poor in the City of Augusta.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city council of the city of
2 Augusta shall, on the third Monday of March, in
3 the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-
4 five, or as soon thereafter as conveniently may be,
5 elect three assessors, one of whom shall be elected
6 for three years, one for two years and one for one
7 year; and thereafter, except to fill vacancies, one
8 assessor shall be elected each year for the term of
9 three years.

SECT. 2. The city council of the city of Augusta shall, on the third Monday of March, aforesaid, or as soon thereafter as conveniently may be, elect three overseers of the poor, one of whom shall be elected for three years, one for two years and one for one year; and thereafter, except to fill vacancies, one overseer of the poor shall be elected each year for the term of three years.

SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
